

# Overview of Testing Schedule for 2022-2023

## September 2022

- 1-9 **Brigance** (Grades: FACE & Kindergarten)  
Purpose: Cognitive, Physical Development, Language, Literacy, and Mathematics, individually tested by classroom teacher.  
Time: 20 minutes  
Results: Shared at fall parent conferences.
- 1-9 **Pre LevelSet-Achieve 3000– Reading support program.** (3-12)  
Purpose: To establish student individual Lexile level to provide appropriate level of instruction and target instruction.  
Time: 40 min.  
Results: given to students, teachers and parents.  
**Smarty Ants:** (K-2)  
Purpose: to establish mastery of foundation literacy skills so we can close achievement gap.
- 12-23 **Northwest Evaluation Association-Measure of Academic Progress** (NWEA: FACE -11)  
Purpose: District adaptive test used to measure student progress over time. Measures student academic growth in Math, Reading, and Science over time and informs classroom instruction and individual student progress.  
Time: 45 Minutes, online reading, math, & science  
Results: Shared with parents at conference.

## November 2022

9:00 am in computer Lab  
Purpose: Optional – two-year Minnesota College Entrance Exam to determine college readiness  
Time: 1.5 hours, online  
Results: Shared with students when they complete testing

- 6 Achieve 3000: Interim Level Set:  
All Students (3-12)

## January 2023

- 4 Achieve 3000: Mid-year Smarty Ants K-  
9-27 **NWEA** (FACE-11) Middle of Year

## March 2023

- 2 **ASVAB** (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery)  
Purpose: Optional College Career Readiness Aptitude Battery of tests  
Time: 3 hours, online  
Results: Shared with students and mailed home.
- 13-17 MCA Science

## April 2023

- 3-28 **Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments** (MCA) Reading & Math & Science and MTAS  
Purpose: Required for state and federal accountability. The MCA's measure student performance related to the Minnesota state academic standards in reading, math, and science. Informs content alignment to state standards decisions system-wide.  
Time: 2-4 hours, online  
Results: Teachers discuss with students and results are mailed home.
- 25 **ACT + Writing grade 11:** ACT College and Career Readiness System, online  
Purpose: Measures student academic college readiness. State required opportunity to take the ACT + Writing for all juniors.  
Time: 4 hours, online  
Results: Results are mailed to students home by ACT.

1-19 NWEA (FACE - 11) End of Year

Purpose: To screen and monitor reading and math skills of students to enable early intervention.
