The COVID-19 vaccines cannot change your DNA, and cannot cause COVID-19: The mRNA (messenger RNA) in the Pfizer vaccine is not able to change or modify a person's genetic makeup (DNA), because it never enters the center of cells, which is where DNA is made. The mRNA vaccines do not contain any live virus. Instead, they work by teaching our cells to make a harmless piece of a "spike protein," which is found on the surface of the virus that causes COVID-19. After making the protein piece, cells display it on their surface. Our immune system then recognizes that it does not belong there and responds to get rid of it. When an immune response begins, antibodies are produced, creating the same response that happens in a natural infection.

Can my 12-17 year old also get vaccinated at this clinic?

No – the dosage for ages 5-11 is different than 12+. Only children ages 5-11 will be accepted at this clinic.

How do I know the vaccine is safe and effective?

The CDC is constantly monitoring vaccine safety. Data shows that COVID-19 vaccines are much safer than getting COVID-19.
