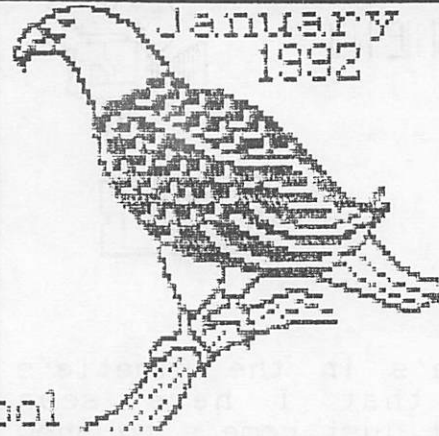
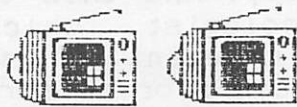

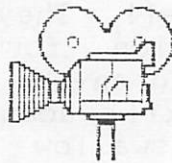

## Interactive Television

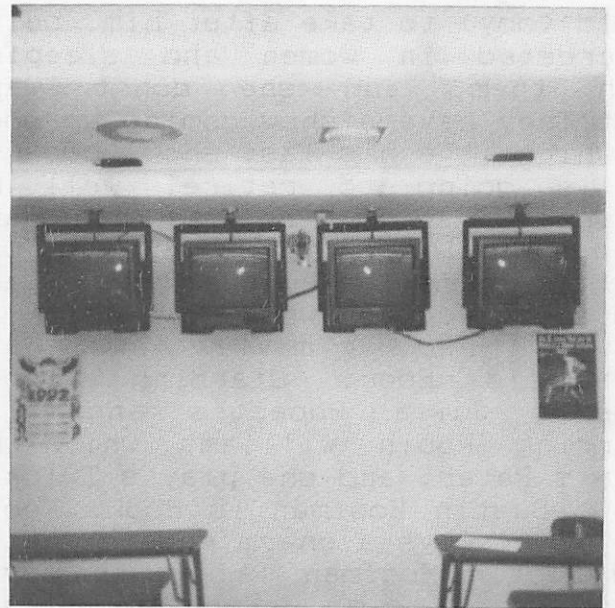

Another student who attends this course goes to the college is Glenn Tiessen.

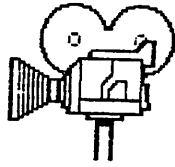
Other schools that have this course are Albrook, and Carlton High School.

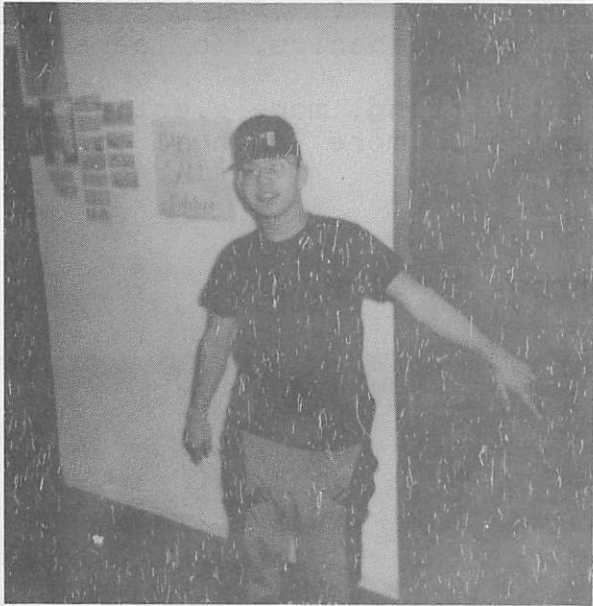
